

Levels of Change with Enterprise-Wide Systems

4. Transformation

- Value chain transformation
- New business model
- Executive visioning & leadership
- Systematic risk & value management
- Mobilization of hierarchy & workforce
- Sophisticated governance structure

3. Cross-Functional Integration

- Work reorganized around cross-functional processes
- New process-based performance indicators
- More analytical tasks at end user level
- Information availability and transparency
- Organizational reengineering
- Cascading sponsorship (executive + operations)
- New KPI's and dashboard
- Integrated change management & value management

2. Process Standardization/Enhancement

- Adoption of standard processes across departments
- Some new system functionality + role enhancement
- Role-based education & training
- Integrated change management (impact analysis, communication, sponsorship)

1. Reproduce Legacy Functionality

- Little process & job change (i.e technical upgrade)
- Legacy functionality exactly reproduced
- Basic systems training
- Basic information & communication
- NOTE: modifications to standard Enterprise System package -> higher cost
